The C-633 Series is a heavy duty wall hydrant designed for installation in mild climates or areas with minimal freeze conditions. The C-633NSV has a versatile 360° swivel, while the C-633NCC has a straight brass pipe connection. Both models have inlets that will connect to either 3/4" MPT or 1" FPT pipe in tight spaces. These commercial wall hydrants are key operated, code approved, and flow up to 16 GPM. The PRIER C-633 Mild Climate Wall Hydrants provide a year-round hose threaded source of water for structures.


The ASSE 1052-approved integral vacuum breaker/backflow preventer provides protection against cross-connection with the potable water system, utilizing a double check valve to prevent back pressure and a vacuum breaker to vent in the case of siphonage. A removable operating key is provided to prevent unauthorized use of the hydrant.





### **SPECS**

Furnish and install (choose <u>C-633NSV Model</u>) or <u>C-633NCC Model</u>) commercial key operated wall hydrant manufactured by PRIER Products, Inc. Hydrant shall be surface mounted and shall have automatic draining capabilities with integral vacuum breaker/backflow preventer. Hydrant shall be capable of flowing a minimum of 16 gallons per minute at 25 PSI differential. Hydrant shaft shall be brass with double connections. Hydrant shall have (choose ¾" or 1") hose connection with self draining functions, one piece valve plunger, satin nickel finish, brass operating rod with positive triple-seal shutoff mechanism. Hydrant shall be approved under ASSE 1052 standards. Operating key with lanyard to be furnished with each hydrant. Hydrant insertion to be specified as <u>C-633NCC</u> (straight with ¾"FPT x 1" MPT connections), <u>C-633PCC</u> (straight with ¾" x 1" sweat connections), <u>C-633VCC</u> (straight with 3/4" press-ready connection) or <u>C-633NSV</u> (360° swivel with ¾" FPT x 1" MPT connections).

Optional: Furnish and install flush-mount hydrant box for each valve. Hydrant box shall be manufactured of solid cast brass or aluminum with a <u>rough brass</u>, <u>satin nickel</u> <u>plated brass</u> or <u>aluminum</u> (choose one) finish. Box shape may be round or square and round box only comes with satin nickel finish. Box may be installed separately and hydrant be insertable and removable from front of the box. Access to the hydrant box shall be provided by the same operating key as the valve. A gasket shall be installed between the box and hydrant to prevent water intrusion into the structure.
